


What you'll need:


- ✓ FFG (2F) Black Powder (1 pound makes 90 to 100 cartridges)
- ✓ 15 to 20 lb. weight paper for making cartridges (Lighter paper will not hold together and heavier will be too difficult to tear with your teeth; newsprint and brown kraft work well)
- ✓ Template for making cartridge paper trapezoids (Use the pattern above to make one of thin cardboard that will stand up to multiple tracings)
- ✓ Wooden form: 7/16" dowel, 6" long. Use a 3/8" drill to bore out a conical depression at one end.
- ✓ Powder measure (set to approximately 60 grains)




1. Trace cartridge pattern on paper and cut out




- 2. Lay form on paper, end with depression toward the top
- 3. Roll it up tight, leaving 1/2" to 3/4" of cartridge beyond end of form





4. Twist End closed





- 7. Flatten top of cartridge above powder
- 8. Fold over sides of flatten section toward center
- 9. Fold over top, fold line should be about 1/4" to 3/8" above powder line (view is from the side)
- 10. Now fold the top back on itself (double fold)

If you use the proper weight paper, this should hold forever
